

This morning travel to Little Rock, the capital of Arkansas. Visit the Clinton Presidential Library & Museum featuring replicas of the Oval Office and the Cabinet Room, photograph and video exhibits and a time line presenting the work of the President. ## **DAY 5: MEMPHIS**

This morning enjoy a tour of Elvis Presley's famous Graceland, a 14-acre estate, museum and entertainment complex. Travel along the Mississippi River, see Victorian homes and cultural landmarks like the Pyramid Arena. This afternoon visit the National Civil Rights Museum, an experience that covers centuries of history. Later stop at the historic Peabody Hotel to see the famous Peabody Duck March through the lobby.
