





## A SHORT HISTORY OF THE BRIGHTON SENIOR CENTER 50 YEARS... 1974 - 2024

The Brighton Senior Center was born when an old schoolhouse, (Rickett School) closed its doors in 1974. The Brighton Area Schools owned this building and had no immediate plans to utilize it for K-12 purposes. The Community Education Department quickly responded with a proposal to the Board of Education to utilize the building for senior center activities. The Board approved the request and during the 1974-75 school year the Brighton Senior Citizen Center became a reality.

In the summer of 1984 the district closed Miller Elementary School as a result of declining enrollments. The Community Education Department's request to re-open Miller as a Community Center was approved in August, 1984. After 10 years at the old Rickett School, the Brighton Senior Center was moved to Miller. The Miller building was also the birthplace of Tot Spot Child Care Center, Phoenix Alternative High School, The Adult High School Learning Center and Washtenaw Community College Regional Center. The Golden Opportunities Program also moved into this location.

The year 1988 saw the construction of a new building, called the Intergenerational Learning Center, built as an addition to the Miller School. This is the current home of the Brighton Senior Center. If you think about it, those born in 1974 are now eligible for Senior Center Membership!
